Book: She's got this by Olympic Gymnast Laurie Hernandez. The book tells the story of Zoe, who wants to fly and decides to become a gymnast.

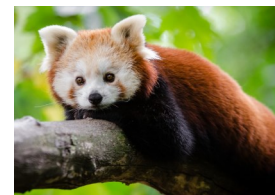


Week 7 Theme: Colors
