ATTENTION DOG WALKERS:

. USE CAUTION

- ❖ Coyotes are territorial and may aggressively approach dog walkers – especially in the spring/summer when raising young.
- ❖ Dogs should be leashed or under close supervision at all times while outside

. IF APPROACHED, DO NOT RUN

- Calmly leave the area
- To frighten coyotes: shout, wave your arms and act aggressive, throw objects
- Do NOT pick up your dog

COYOTES MAY EXHIBIT BOLD BEHAVIOR AROUND PEOPLE, HOWEVER AGGRESSIVE BEHAVIOR TOWARDS PEOPLE IS RARE. ANY COYOTE ACTING AGGRESSIVELY TOWARDS PEOPLE OR SUPERVISED PETS SHOULD BE REPORTED TO YOUR OLD SAYBROOK POLICE AT 860-395-3142 OR DEEP ENCON POLICE AT (860) 424-3333.
