# Rules

- Teams must have 4 players and be co-ed (**ROSTERS ARE FINAL**)
- Your team must be there both nights; **no substituting players**
- This is a co-ed tournament
- There will be **no goalies**
- Teams will not be allowed in goalie box
- You **cannot use your hands**, it will result in loss of possession and a penalty kick
- **No slide tackling**, this will result in a penalty
- Penalties will last 1 minute or until a goal has been scored by the opposing team
- Walls are in play

## Game Play

- Games will last 5 minutes or until a team has scored 3 goals. At the end of 5 minutes the team with the most goals wins
- Games will start with a coin flip and the winning team will take the ball from their goal
- In the result of a tie, a shoot-out will occur; each team player will get 1 kick to try to score. If it is a half-court game, it will be a full court kick, if it is a full court game the kick will be from center court.
